CREW Network Recognizes Pamela Bundy Foster with Achievement of Excellence Award at Annual Convention

Lawrence, KS – September 19, 2011 – At its Annual Convention & Marketplace in Washington, DC this week, Commercial Real Estate Women (CREW) Network recognized Pamela Bundy Foster with the Achievement of Excellence Award.

Foster, who also received the organization's Entrepreneurial Spirit Award, founded Bundy Development Corporation (BDC) as a vehicle to realize her vision of creating thriving city neighborhoods in her adopted hometown – Washington, DC. Over the past decade, BDC has been a pioneer in urban-style developments that have been an integral part in the rebirth of Washington DC's downtown.

Bundy has grown BDC to embrace large, ground-up developments including The Castle, The Icon and the 6th Street Flats. Today, these communities are among the most recognizable in the District.

Today, BDC is a key development partner in two of the District's largest and most well-recognized mixed-use projects currently underdevelopment and implementation: City Vista and CityCenter DC.

City Vista incorporated an urban dynamic with its' center-city location, close proximity to public transportation, and pedestrian convenience including having all major amenities located within blocks of the residences. The development provided more than 441 condominium units, 229 apartment units, and over 100,000 square feet of retail.

CityCenterDC includes 500 apartments, 185,000 square feet of retail space including high-end department stores, 500,000 square feet of office space, 1555 underground parking spaces, and one open acre of green space.

The total project value is more than \$1 billion, making it the single largest development in the District, as well as the largest urban infield development on the east coast.

"Pamela Bundy Foster exemplifies entrepreneurialism and is a role model for women in commercial real estate," said 2011 CREW Network President Collete English Dixon. "She is recognized for an entrepreneurial vision that has changed the lives of people in her community."
