**ICREW NJ Hosts DEP's Irene Kropp at Special "Hot Topic" Presentation
On New Site Remediation Reform Act and LSRP Program**

Woodbridge, NJ – The New Jersey Chapter of Industrial Commercial Real Estate Women, Inc. (ICREW NJ) was honored to host NJDEP Assistant Commissioner Irene Kropp at a recent breakfast and special educational session, which was held at the Woodbridge Hilton on Friday, May 29, 2009.

Ms. Kropp was joined by ICREW NJ members Susan C. Karp and Laura Brinkerhoff as panelists for a timely and comprehensive presentation on the new Site Remediation Reform Act and its Licensed Site Remediation Professional (LSRP) Program, which Governor Corzine signed into law on May 7, 2009.

The State's decision to reform its site remediation process has New Jersey's environmental and redevelopment communities buzzing. According to Ms. Karp, who is also a member of ICREW NJ's Programming Committee, "Being prepared to manage the impact of this important legislation on both existing and future real estate deals will be essential for industry professionals involved in those transactions, and ICREW NJ is responding to that need with this program." She added, "Ms. Kropp is a key player in both the drafting and implementation of the new law, and ICREW NJ is delighted that she found the time to address our group."

The program was open to both ICREW NJ members and the general public. Attendees received a broad-based overview of the Site Remediation Reform Act, with a special focus on those aspects of the law which will bring wide-ranging changes to transactions and redevelopment, as well as strategies for making deals work within the parameters of the new law.
